11. Biennial Budget Update

Ms. Tammy Dolan provided the committee with information regarding the following:

- 2021-23 Budget Request Process moving forward as planned
- Expect Governor's budget guidelines end of April / 1st week of May
- OMB working with Moody's on new revenue forecast that will serve as the basis for budget guidelines and any mid-biennium budget adjustments or allotments
- Have been preparing background information for 2021-23 budget request. Will move full speed ahead when guidelines are released.
- Will discuss with BFC at meetings in May & June, with hopes of getting SBHE approval at end of June.
- COVID Pandemic implications & costs (\$20 million minimum may be partially offset by federal relief funding continues to grow), federal relief funding, drop off in energy sector, difficult agriculture sector all will impact the State's revenue forecast for both this biennium and the next. The extent to which is unknown at this time. More unknown than known at this time. Due to uncertainties, institutions & System Office operating very conservatively. Hiring chill/frost/freeze at all entities, to ensure only most critical positions are filled. Limiting unnecessary expenditures. While still moving forward, adapting to new normal.

12. COVID-19 Implications/Plans

Chancellor Hagerott will continue to work with the campuses on plans moving forward; the COVID-19 environment is continually changing, and period updates will be provided to the Board.
