# North Dakota State Board of Higher Education Academic and Student Affairs Committee

June 16, 2020, Meeting Minutes

The State Board of Higher Education's Academic and Student Affairs Committee met Tuesday, June 16, 2020, at 11:00 a.m. CT. via conference call originating from the 10<sup>th</sup> floor of the State Capitol, NDUS Conference Room, 600 E. Boulevard Ave., Bismarck, ND.

Chair Louters called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. CT.
