## 2. North Dakota State College of Science Oversight/Audit Plan

Chancellor Hagerott reviewed the North Dakota State College of Science Audit Plan that the SBHE directed him to oversee beyond his normal supervision of President Richman and NDSCS campus at the June 2019 SBHE meeting. The oversight plan has been reviewed over the course of the year. President Richman and NDSCS provided Chancellor Hagerott with updates to the action plan, the updates were reviewed by leadership at the system office. The Chancellor, system

office leadership, President Richman, and other NDSCS representatives worked through the individual components to complete the SBHE request. He further explained that NDSCS will go before the Legislative Audit and Fiscal Review Committee (LAFRC) in July. He will keep the committee informed if any follow-up from that meeting needs to take place.

Chair Neset expressed she still has concerns with the climate/environment on the NDSCS campus and requests to review the last campus climate survey and have the next climate survey be reviewed by the committee to determine if further action is needed. NDSCS indicated the next survey would come available in 2021 due to the time it takes to administer, review, and compile. The committee recommended another survey be completed at a sooner date, if possible.
