3. Temporary Waiver to Policy HR 6(5)

Ms. Grinde reviewed the proposal to temporarily waive section five of <u>Policy HR6 (5)</u> for calendar year 2020.

Ryan moved, Bye seconded, to recommend approval of a waiver to policy HR6, section five, for calendar year 2020 only.

Ryan, Bye, and Mihalick voted yes.

4. 2021-2022 Room, Board, and Fee Guidelines

Mr. Krebsbach proposed 2021-22 room, board, and fee guidelines.

Bye moved, Ryan seconded, to recommend approval of the proposed 2021-22 room, board, and fee guidelines as presented.

Bye, Ryan, and Mihalick voted yes.

5. UND Nistler Hall

Ryan moved, Bye seconded, to recommend approval of the attached resolution authorizing University of North Dakota Alumni Association & Foundation <u>(UNDAAF)</u> to issue not more than \$30 million in University Facilities Bond, Series 2020 tax-exempt bonds on behalf of North Dakota University System (NDUS) to finance the construction of Nistler Hall.

Ryan, Bye, and Mihalick voted yes.

6. Redesign Campus Road for Fuel Delivery (UNDAAF)

Moved, seconded, to recommend approval for <u>UND to purchase real property</u>, a portion of parcel 44311700054005, from UND Alumni Association and Foundation, and furthermore authorize UND to seek legislative approval for the purchase.

7. NDSU Agricultural Experiment Station (NDAES)

Moved, seconded, to recommend approval for NDSU to rename the <u>ND Agricultural Experiment</u> <u>Station (NDAES) Research</u> Greenhouse to the John Stewart Dalrymple III Agricultural Research Greenhouse as per SBHE Policy 902.12.

Ryan, Bye, and Mihalick voted yes.

8. UND Partner with Private Developers to Build Private Market-rate Housing on Campus

Bye moved, Ryan seconded to recommend approval for <u>UND to sell real property</u> as described in the Summary of Proposed Action to UND Alumni Association & Foundation for \$1 with the stipulation that guarantees the UND to sell real property as described in the Summary of Proposed Action to UND Alumni Association & Foundation for \$1 with the stipulation that guarantees the development of the properties will be used for the continued benefit of UND as determined by UND, and request the SBHE or a designee of the board to approve the terms of the conveyance.

The committee discussed that this is the preliminary first step; full SBHE approval and to seek legislative approval is still needed. If any additional contingencies, the committee would like to re-visit.

Bye moved, Ryan seconded, to recommend approval for UND to Partner with private developers to build private market-rate housing on campus, as discussed.

Bye, Ryan, and Mihalick voted yes.

9. UND to proceed with private development of state infrastructure (Student Housing) Ryan moved, Bye seconded, to recommend approval for UND to proceed with private development of state infrastructure as per NDCC § 48-02.1 to construct and remodel UND <u>affiliated student housing</u> and to seek legislative authority to proceed with the project.

Ryan, Bye, and Mihalick voted yes.

10. UND Accept a g Gift of Real Property (2423 University Ave., Grand Forks, N.D.)

Ryan moved, Bye seconded, to recommend approval for <u>UND to accept a gift of real property</u> (2423 University Ave., Grand Forks, N.D.) from UND Alumni Association & Foundation.

Bye, Ryan, and Mihalick voted yes.

LRSC Money Transfer into Capitol Building Fund Appropriation
 Bye moved, Ryan seconded, to recommend approval to ratify Chancellor's approval of a
 <u>\$225,000 transfer</u> of the NDUS System Office Tier IIII capital building fund appropriation line to the
 LRSC capital building fund appropriation line.
