Call to Order

- 1. Recap of Week's Activity
 - HB1161 Relates to funding for vacant full-time equivalent positions. Received a "do not pass" from the Senate Appropriations Committee and will be voted on the Senate floor next week
 - HB1437 The tenure bill. There were amendments approved by the Senate, making the bill more aligned with updated SBHE tenure policies. The amended bill will go to the Senate floor next week.
 - Meetings with the House Appropriations Education and Environment Division took place regarding SB 2003. Key discussion points included SBHE processes, specifically the handling of institution president separation agreements and search timelines.
- 2. Preview of Next Week's Legislative Hearings
 Ms. Dolan highlighted the bills the NDUS is tracking which are scheduled for a hearing next week.

HB 1265 – Creation of the state information technology research center. Scheduled for a hearing on Wednesday morning at 9:00 AM in the Senate Education Committee. The date and time may change due to scheduling conflicts for the bill carrier. SB 2003 – The appropriations bill will continue to be worked on next week in the House Appropriations Committee Education & Environment Division, but exact times and dates are not yet posted.

3. Discussion of SBHE Legislative Priorities and Positions
Board members reviewed the SBHE stance on the specific bills that NDUS is tracking.
