The ND Career Builders program provides matching funds to help North Dakota businesses recruit employees and keep our talent in North Dakota. We are seeking businesses to participate and invest in this unique partnership!

A tool for businesses to recruit and retain talent in high-need occupations in ND, this innovative partnership provides \$1 of state funds for each \$1 of private-sector matching funds, up to a total of \$17,000 per recipient! Individuals can receive a scholarship on the front end, loan

repayment on the back-end, or both, for their commitment to the state to fill one of the high-demand occupations. It is a win-win for businesses, students, employees, and the state!

The program is driven by high-demand occupations in healthcare, manufacturing, information technology, industrial and skilled trades, education, social services and professional services.
