## Methodology

Program enrollment data presented in this report represents North Dakota University System (NDUS) student program enrollment during Fall 2022 academic term. Data is collected as of enrollment census date (9/19/2022) and correspond to what is reported in the **2022 NDUS Fall Enrollment Report**.

Data is presented in two sections. The undergraduate section (pages UG-1 – UG-7) accounts for 36,959 undergraduate students enrolled in NDUS in Fall 2022 academic term. The graduate section (pages GR-1 – GR-4) account for the 6,586 graduate and professional level students enrolled during this same term. In total, 43,585 student enrollments are represented in this report. A summary table is presented in Table 1.

Program enrollment data accounts for student enrollment in a program at each institution of attendance. Although program enrollments counted in this report are unduplicated at the institution level, students who enroll at multiple institutions are counted at each institution, producing a duplicated student count.

## CIP Codes

All NDUS academic programs are categorized by unique CIP codes. Each CIP code has a corresponding program description. The CIP code taxonomy is maintained by the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) in the U.S. Department of Education. CIP codes consists of 47 academic categories, and each academic program is represented by a unique six-digit CIP code.
