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## **Executive Summary**

This report shows all certificates and degrees awarded in the NDUS between July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Total awards completed reflect both first and second majors in cases where dual degrees were reported. In total, NDUS institutions awarded 10,747 certificates and degrees of which 10,404 were first majors and 343 were second majors. A summary table by institution is presented in Table I.

Program completion data is summarized by institution, by tier, and overall total for the North Dakota University System.

The appendix shows total completions for the North Dakota private and tribal institutions. In total, North Dakota tribal colleges awarded 456 certificates and degrees, and North Dakota private institutions awarded 1,331 certificates and degrees.

The total number of certificates and degrees awarded by all North Dakota public, private and tribal institutions in 2022-2023 is 12,534.

## **Method**

Degree completion data presented in this report summarizes the data reported by each NDUS institutional Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) *COM Survey*. Data is inclusive for the Summer 2022, Fall 2022, and Spring 2023 academic terms (Inclusive dates of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023).

IPEDS reported data includes student program completion by Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) code and level of award (certificate or degree). CIP codes are developed by the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) and consist of a taxonomy in which every postsecondary instructional program is classified by a six-digit code.

CIP codes are used in this Programs Completed report to identify programs in which NDUS students were awarded certificates or degrees at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The following table identifies the IPEDS award level for completed programs, as well as the corresponding abbreviation used in this report. The award levels were changed in the 2019-2020 reporting year by IPEDS to add additional detail at the less than one-year certificate award level. This change is reflected in the Program Completed report abbreviations used throughout this report.
