What We Are Not

- "Closing the Book on the College Bookstore Scam" (Forbes, 2024)
 - NDSU Bookstore does not bundle course material costs into tuition/fees
 - Opt-Out process is transparent and well-publicized
 - Claims regarding margins are not true of independent, campusowned stores like the NDSU Bookstore
 - OER is not entirely free
 - time to create and update, grants, donations, cost of printed copies, etc...



NDSU Bookstore

- Course material discovery
 - Adoption system has Affordability Scores
 - Faculty Center Network <u>www.facultycenter.net/fc_home.php</u>
- We still do print!
 - New, used, coursepacks (NDSU Print & Copy Services, LAD Custom Publishing)
- Non-book items
 - Art/Supplies art/design kits, specialized notebooks
 - Technology calculators, clickers



NDSU Bookstore

- Digital
 - Inclusive Access
 - Non-Inclusive Access
- What is Inclusive Access?
 - Digital materials that students access via a link in LMS course
 - eBooks or homework items
 - Billed to student account (no credit card needed!)
 - NDSU students have through Add/Drop deadline to try it out and opt out if they want (approximately 10 days into semester)



Inclusive Access

Benefits

- Quick implementation
- Avoid paper shortages and transit issues
- Convenience of digital access, right there in the LMS course
- Savings over print and regular-priced digital versions
- Low-cost print supplements
- First-day access for students
 - Improvements in student outcomes
 - Four studies done www.CourseMaterialsResearch.com
 - Did we mention convenience?
 - Students do not have to take additional steps to opt in



Inclusive Access

- Inclusive Access has been offered at NDSU since 2016-17 academic year
- Fall 2023
 - 11% increase from Fall 2022 in items, to 446
 - 11% increase from Fall 2022 in sections, to 973
 - 973 is only 25% of our total sections but, through these sections, 83% of our student body had at least one IA item and 93.5% of them participated
 - Fairly even mix of courseware and eBook items
 - Estimated Student Savings (off DLP) \$585,153
- Spring 2024
 - 14% increase from Spring 2023 in items, to 433
 - 13% increase from Spring 2023 in sections, to 871
 - 871 is only 24% of our total sections but, through these sections, 75% of our student body has at least one IA item and 92.5% of them are participating
 - Fairly even mix of courseware and eBook items
 - Estimated Student Savings (off DLP) \$434,341
