Financial Assistance Available for Qualified Students in High-Demand Occupation Programs at ND Institutions

The ND Career Builders program offers scholarships and student loan repayment in high-demand occupations within the healthcare, manufacturing, information technology, industrial and skilled trades, education, social services and professional services industries. For a complete list of qualifying occupations and programs visit ndus.edu/career-builders.

Qualifying ND institutions include public, private, tribal and proprietary colleges. Students must be admitted into a qualifying certificate or degree program in the state that relates to a high-need occupation. Qualifying programs are those at the associates level and below, or bachelor level programs in the final two years of the student's program. The institution will initiate the scholarship application process with the student and NDUS will confirm final eligibility based on program guidelines.

Help Businesses in Your Community Recruit High-Demand Talent

The ND Career Builders program requires matching funds. The program relies on high schools, colleges and universities across the state to help connect students with businesses to take advantage of this opportunity. We have seen success when high schools and institutions bring the students and businesses together to establish eligibility.
